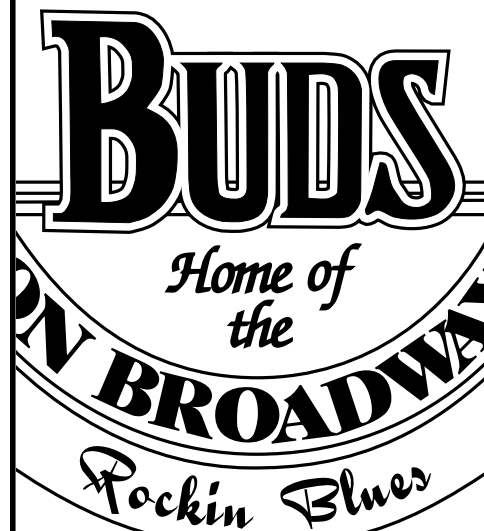

Riff Raff

Saskatoon classic rock band Riff Raff returns to the stage. Veterans of the Canadian nightclub circuit, the band toured all across Canada during the eighties before disbanding in 1989. In March of 1999, the members reunited to perform at a Telemiracle fundraiser. "That was such a great time," says lead vocalist Rory Lawford, "the audience went wild. Saskatchewan is really getting into the classic hard rock sound again, even the younger crowd. This is just way too much fun, so we decided to reunite on a more permanent basis."

Riff Raff's set ranges the gamut of classic hard rock from the late 70's & 80's, (including songs from AC/DC, Nazareth, Alice Cooper, Sweet, Kiss, Iron Maiden, Twisted Sister, Judas Priest & Metallica). "We are a party band," says lead guitarist Brian Kendall, "we don't just play the songs, we like to put on a show." Bucking the trend of dour, angry modern rockers, Riff Raff's live show is a freewheeling, high energy party where everyone is invited to join in on the fun.



BUTTERfinger

Butterfinger recently released its debut self-titled album capitalizing on the momentum of their award-winning song, Breathe. Breathe won the national songwriting competition in conjunction with Canadian Music Week in Toronto in the spring of 2001.

The band's horizons were truly expanded as the project took them to Calgary, Toronto and Los Angeles. The travel the band experienced had a definite impact and was instrumental in the molding of the album's fresh sound. The result is a collection of songs with great guitar hooks and vocal melodies that leave the listener craving more.

The resulting record has exceeded all expectations and generated considerable buzz in anticipation of its release. The band's great live show has only added fuel to the fire. Butterfinger has a loyal and ever-growing fan base. It is not uncommon for hordes of the Butterfinger faithful to drive 3 hours or more just to see them perform.
