BELLAMY**

Brash and gutsy, Clayton Bellamy is a dynamic singer/songwriter who's words and music are a unique reflection of the best of classic country, 70's southern rock and today's story telling roots music. He has dazzled audiences at some of North America's most prestigious festivals with his energetic and interactive live performances. With a strong base of both rock and country fans he has shared the stage with talent like Big House, Kentucky HeadHunters, the Dixie Chicks, theHeadstones and Big Sugar.

Through street level promotion and extensive touring his debut EP, Running On Empty earned him six nominations at the 2000 Alberta Recording Industry Association awards. The title track won him "single of the year" and garnered him top 40 spots on country charts and community, rock and Americana radio Across North America and Europe.



KASHMIR

In their four year history, Kashmir has firmly established itself as an excellent, loud and proud, Led Zepelin tribute. They've been from

Edmonton to Yellowknife to Winnipeg, and now Kashmir (based in Saskatoon) returns home again for another wall to wall weekend at Bud's. The band is powered by Ray Goertzen (bass) Dave Cummine (drums) John Lisi (guitar) and Darcy Clayton. (vocals) They have also expanded to sometimes include a keyboard player (Kevin Barret) and an acoustic set. Kashmir has always packed 'em in at Bud's so make sure to show up early for a good seat, and settle in for an all out Zeppelin assault.



**MEN WITHOUT
SHAME**

This quartet is party rock with a capital 'P'. Performing classic rock tunes from the 70's and early 80's, and delivering them with an attitude that doesn't allow any seriousness, has made them a favorite in the southern part of the Province.


Their stage show, one secret to their popularity, (and proof that their name is accurate) is filled with costumes, hats and general silliness, however it never overshadows the band's tight, guitar driven sound. They deliver on song's like Nazareth's 'This Flight Tonight' and Sweeny Todd's 'Roxy Roller'.

Their debut CD has sold thousands of copies in the south and in fact, their version of "Roxy Roller" gets more airplay on Regina radio than the original does.
