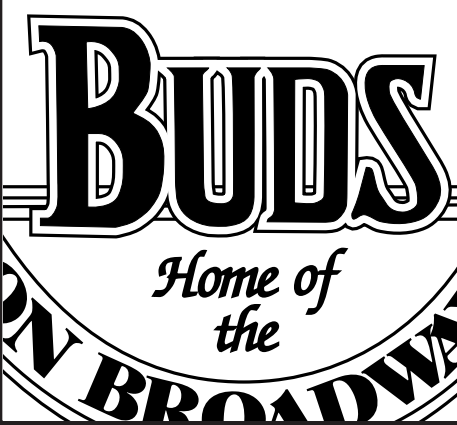

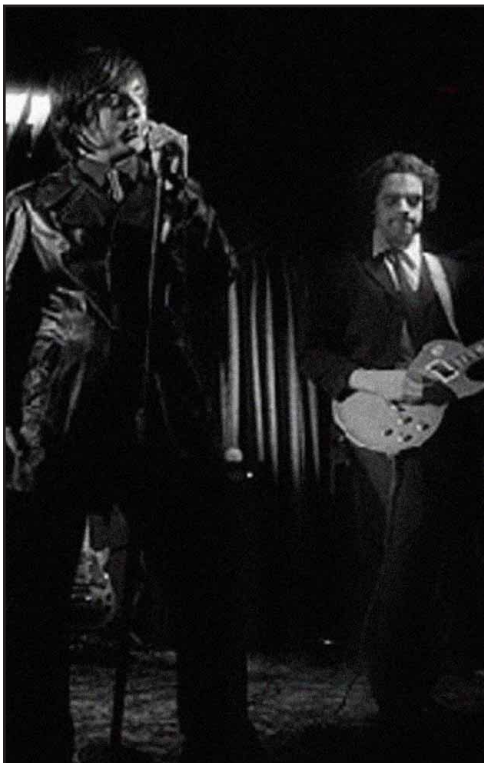


parlor TriXX

KASHMIR

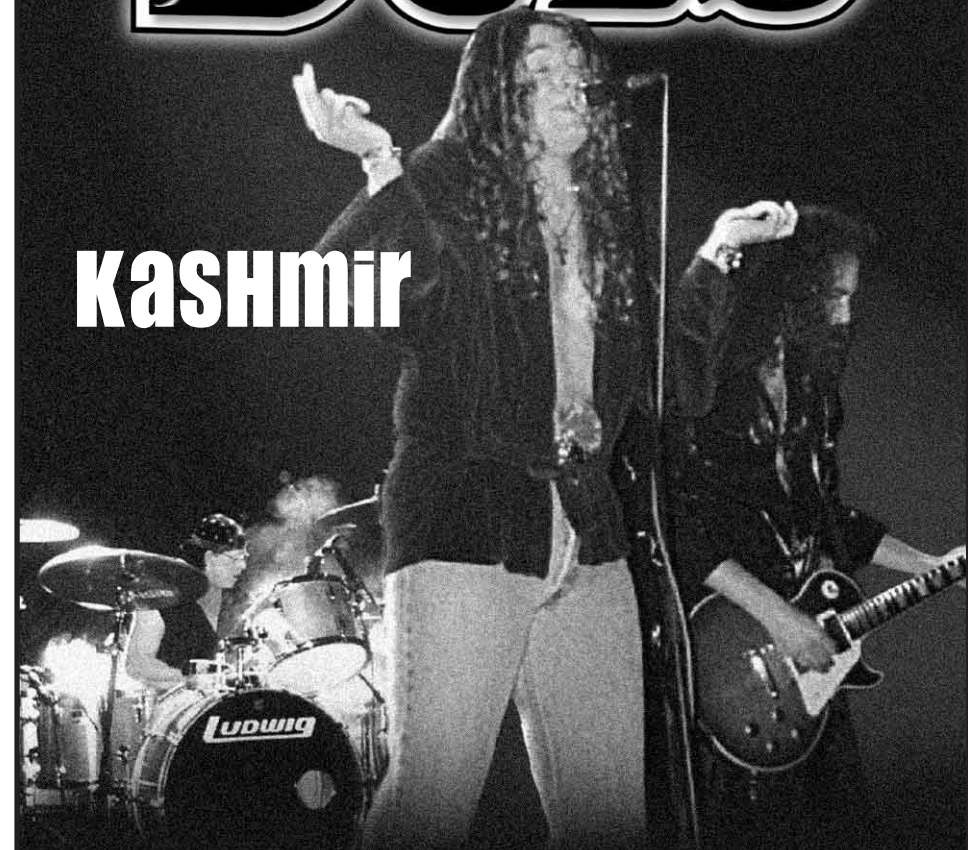
